- Efficiency with Fewer Files: Design enhancements that deliver consistent canal shapes in less time and with fewer instruments.
- Energized Irrigation Protocols: New technologies and techniques for removing bacteria and the smear layer.
- Obturation: State of the art, centrally condensed gutta-percha technologies vs. single-cone techniques.

About The Presenter

Dr. Kinra received his dental degree from the University of Michigan, School of Dentistry, in 1999. At that time he proceeded into private practice for the next 3 years. In 2002, he returned to obtain his masters degree in endodontics at the University of Detroit-Mercy, School of Dentistry. In 2004, after the completion of his postgraduate degree, he immediately began his solo private practice limited to endodontics in Flint, Michigan.

Dr. Kinra is an Adjunct Professor of Graduate Endodontics and Graduate Periodontics at the University of Detroit-Mercy, School of Dentistry.
